to become research assistants and contribute to Canine Health. The CHIC DNA Repository and The Dalmatian Club of America are pleased to announce that they will be holding a DNA Collection Clinic at the Greater Pittsburgh Dalmatian Club Specialty show on Friday, June 25, 2010.

DNA samples will be collected via blood samples and will be stored at the University of Missouri-Columbia. Approximately 5-10ccs of whole blood will be collected per dog. The sample process is quick and should not affect the dog. All collection and storage costs are being underwritten by The Dalmatian Club of America Foundation and the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals.

Pre-registration IS NOT required, although it is recommended and requested that the owners complete the required paperwork ahead of time. Forms can be downloaded from the DCA website: [www.thedca.org](http://www.thedca.org).

Forms will also be available the day of the show. Please join us after our specialty's complimentary lunch to participate in the blood draw.

STUD DOG CLASS where indicated, will be for Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excused under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed (Variety) competition, or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS, same as for Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

At the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making of the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.
